LOUNGE RULES

1. The Lounge is open to current members of the American Legion Post 116 Family and their guests.
 - a. Membership cards may be checked at any time.
 - b. Members of other veterans' organizations will be admitted as guests.
 - c. Active-Duty Armed Forces personnel will be admitted as guests.
 - d. All guests must sign the Guest Book.
 - e. All guests signed in by a member must leave the lounge when the signing member leaves.
2. Only the bar person or those authorized by the bar person, will open the door for those not using the electronic door card.
3. Lounge Hours:

*Close:

- Monday – Saturday: If after 8 PM and the Lounge has fewer than five (5) members present, not including the Lounge employee, the Lounge employee will make “Last Call” and close the Lounge.
 - Sunday: If after 7 PM and the Lounge has fewer than five (5) members present, not including the Lounge employee, the Lounge employee will make “Last Call” and close the Lounge.
4. Minors must leave the lounge by 9:00 pm. All minors must sit at the tables, not at the bar. Minors shall not play gaming devices or tickets.
 5. In adverse weather the Lounge will not open if the County offices are closed or will be closed during the weather event.
 6. Last Call will be called ½ hour before closing. All alcoholic beverages will be off the table/bar by 2:00 am (No exemptions...it's the law!)
 7. No games are to be started after Last Call on any machine or pool table.
 8. Lounge priorities are drinks, gambling, and food in that order.
 9. No alcoholic beverages are to be brought into the Lounge or removed from the property.
 10. The County Liquor Board requires Lounge staff to be trained in identifying potential excessive alcohol consumption. If the employee believes the member or guest has had excessive alcohol consumption, they may refuse to serve alcohol to anyone.
 11. Any member or guest causing a disturbance will be subject to disciplinary action to include the denial of lounge privileges.
 12. Loud, vulgar, or abusive language will not be tolerated.
 13. Shirts and shoes are required.
 14. No pets are allowed except for service dogs.
 15. Televisions will take precedence over the jukebox during special events i.e., play-off games, Ravens games, national news events, etc. The Lounge staff will control the TVs and jukebox volume. The volume will be reasonable for all members.
 16. The cashing of personal checks is not allowed, however, they may be used to pay a bar tab. The use of the ATM Machine or Credit Card Machine can be used in lieu of cashing checks.
