
One of the most important offices that needs to be filled is that of 1st Vice Commander, our membership chairman. Membership is where it all starts; without members we are nothing!


Remember that membership is a most important program in the Post. We are all recruiters and should be checking our friends, neighbors and relatives to help increase our numbers. We always want to add new members.




